On May 14, 1951, ground was broken for the construction of a much needed school, with Rev. Raymond A. Kearney officiating. The school opened in September, 1952 and was staffed by the Sisters of Mercy of Brooklyn. Almost immediately, the eight classrooms were filled. In 1954 construction was begun again for eight additional classrooms which were completed in 1954. Today Saint Mary is still going strong.

Just for today I will have a programme. I may not follow it exactly, but I will have it, I will save myself from two pests — hurry and indecision.

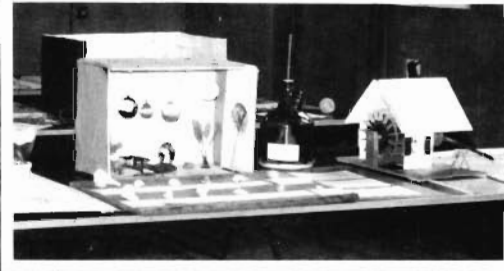
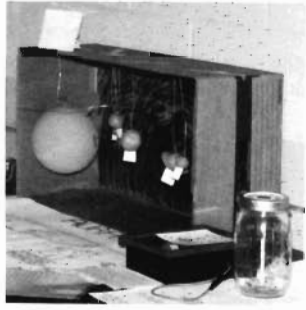
Just for today I will have a quiet half hour all by myself, and relax. During this half hour, sometime, I will try to get a better perspective of my life.

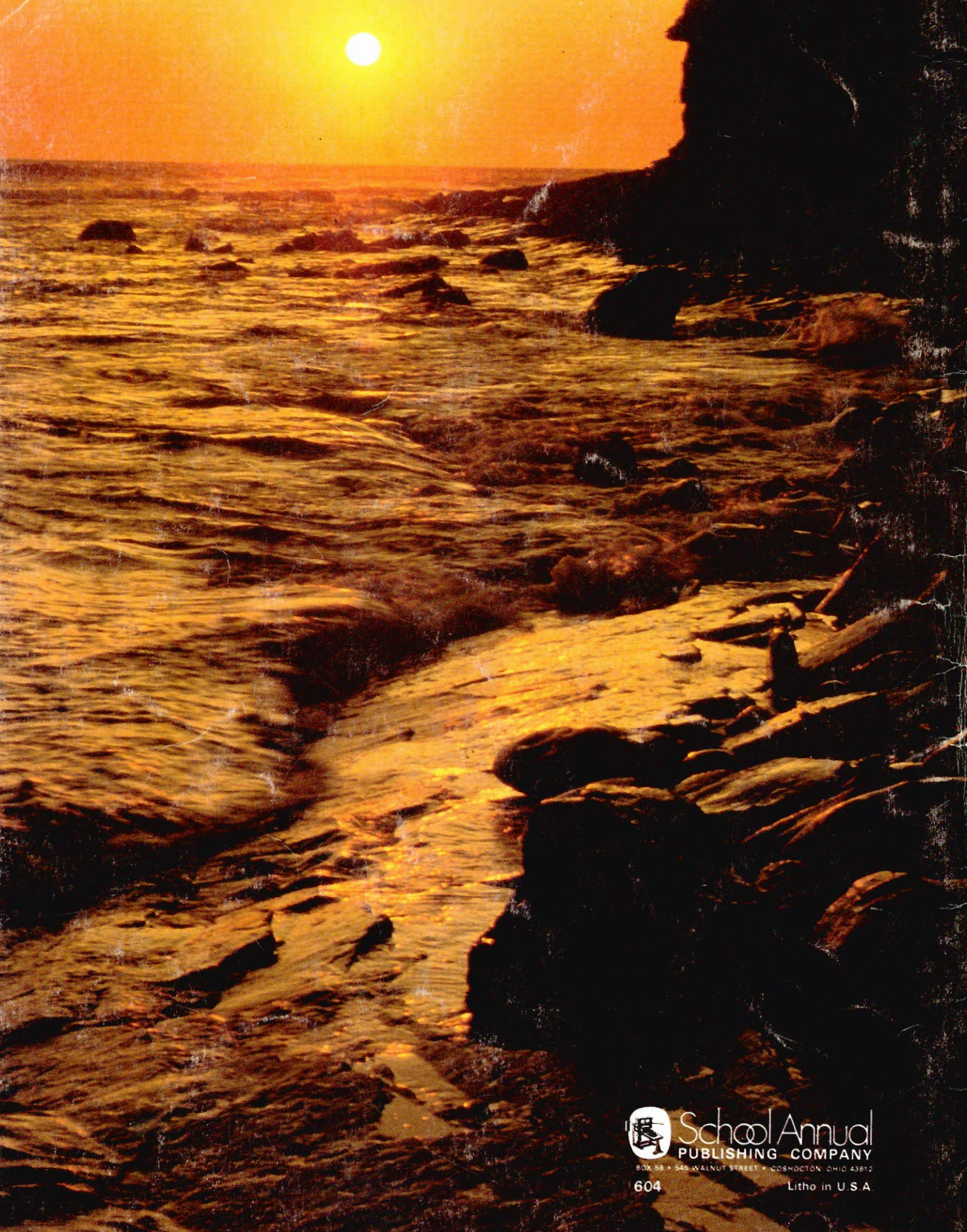
